The Natchez Trace Parkway will be hiring up to five students who are interested in working outdoors in an education and conservation based position. Students will be working alongside park rangers assisting in the operation of environmental summer camps, learning about park resources and working with resource management to remove invasive plants.

Students will have the opportunity to explore the historical and natural side of northern Mississippi while gaining important skills in job and career development.
