UM's Online Graduate Certificate Program in Emotional Disability is designed to prepare teachers to be interventionist in the field of Emotional Behavior Disorders in order to address the needs of individual with EmD eligibilities.

The program philosophy focuses on meeting the needs of individual students who have emotional and behavioral disorders. Upon completion of the program, teachers are prepared to assess, analyze and problem solve the challenges of learning for students with emotional and/ or behavioral disorders and their families, focusing on the objective of providing effective teaching practices, behavioral supports, and instructional strategies.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants to the program must meet these requirements:

- Have a completed bachelor's degree
- Hold a teacher certification in Special Education (Mild/Moderate - 221)
- Completed online application
- Note: Students may pursue the graduate certificate as a stand-alone program that leads to recommendation of the 206 Emotional Disability Add-On Endorsement or as part of a Graduate Degree in Special Education.
