The goal of the conference is to engage the participants in a series of interactive and informational virtual sessions that explore instructional and leadership practices to support educators and leaders of schools and districts that are identified as Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI), Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI), Additional Targeted Support and Improvement (ATSI), and Schools At-Risk (SAR).
