Skills for Life and Learning:
An Introduction to Mississippi's Social Emotional Standards

REACH MS, in partnership with the Mississippi Department of Education, is excited to offer our first K-12 Social Emotional Learning (SEL) training presented in a virtual professional development format - "Skills for Life and Learning: An Introduction to Mississippi's Social Emotional Standards." This 7 module online training will include an introduction to SEL, CASEL's five core competencies, the alignment of SEL with existing initiatives, school wide implementation, teaming, family involvement, an introduction to Mississippi's newly developed K-12 SEL Standards, and assessment tools (school-wide, classroom, teacher, and student). Modules 2-6 will each focus on 1 of the 5 individual domains from the MS K-12 SEL standards, social-emotional learning curricula, and practices and strategies for implementation. Module 7 will provide a wrap up and steps for future implementation and sustainability.
