• What is In One Instant (IOI)?

IOI is an award-winning teen safe driving program that combats the #1 cause of teen fatalities - car crashes. The video-based, interactive program empowers teens to make safe choices and influence their classmates, friends, and family to do the same. <u>Watch this 1-minute video: https://vimeo.com/575996066</u>

- Who developed the program and follow-up activities? Created by teens-for teens, with research and expert input from health and safety professionals, educators, and psychologists, IOI makes the issues relevant, personal, and approachable.
- What does In One Instant cost? IOI is free to high schools and community organizations this year.
- Where has the program been used? IOI has been making a difference in over 3,000 schools and organizations nationwide.
- Can Student Leaders present the program? Yes! Student leadership is the core of IOI's solution. They coordinate implementation with their admin or advisor, and with ongoing IOI mentorship. Teens are ideal presenters since peer-to-peer learning has proven to be highly effective. The program's video and customized guides make it easy to lead the way with their peers. (Can also be presented by educators and adult leaders).
- What is the estimated time needed? And what's in the program? <u>*For prep and planning</u>, less than 30 minutes. Includes signing up, choosing date(s) and time, inviting other participants, coordinating with Student Leaders/other educators. <u>*Video program</u>, 33 minutes. <u>Follow-up activities</u>, 20 min-or expanded to more sessions as time allows.

*Pre & Post Surveys for Students, 3-minutes each.

*The program is flexible and turnkey. It has compelling video content, relatable storytelling, immersive games and activities, real-life survivor testimonials, and follow-up activities that help students apply what they've seen to their own lives. Includes comprehensive toolkits/materials for educators, students, and parents along with community service opportunities. You choose what to include.

• What do teens learn?

Afterwards, teens feel compelled to own the problem and become the solution. They gain a new understanding of: learning how to stand up to peer pressure; refraining from driving while impaired, or driving with impaired drivers; utilizing a designated driver; refraining from using cell phones or texting while driving; wearing seat belts.

• Can it be presented remotely?

The program has been designed to work in-person or virtually via any video platform.

• What results has the program had?

Anonymous pre and post program surveys show that 86% more teens won't text and drive after experiencing the program, and 91% more students won't drive if impaired. 90% pledge to wear seat belts.

- How does my school/org qualify for one of the \$1000 prizes? Once schools/orgs complete the short, online post program survey, they are qualified for a \$1000 prize.
