## CMSE Middle Math Institutes

The CMSE Middle Math Institutes are designed to engage educators the mathematics content taught in grades 6-8. Educators will be eligible for 2.4 CEUs for each content institute. Successful completion of **all four** institutes will allow Mississippi educators to apply for a Supplemental Endorsement in Middle-Level Mathematics (Endorsement Code – 901). 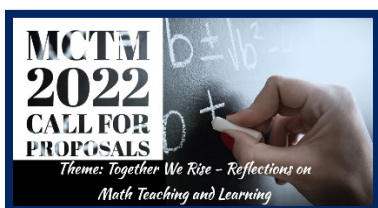
## The Mississippi Association of Mathematics Teacher Educators
