The ideal candidate will have the skills and confidence needed to be the face of MSMS, shouldering the responsibility of providing strategic direction and implementing a progressive vision for the future.

Duties and responsibilities include exhibiting strong leadership for rigorous academic programs; coordinating long- and short-range planning; development and implementation of policies; providing direction for financial, personnel, academic, admissions, and student services matters; serving as a public relations liaison between schools, families, and external organizations and government agencies; and coordinating all aspects of school operations including both academic and residential programs.

- Advanced degree, doctorate preferred, in educational leadership or a related field.
