



## **Mississippi College- and Career- Readiness Standards for Social Studies Review Committee Application**

The purpose of the Mississippi College-and Career-Readiness (MS CCR) Standards for Social Studies Review Committee is to review the proposed changes and APA comments related to the MS CCR Standards for Social Studies, 2018. The committee members will consist of teachers from grades K-12, representing each Congressional District. Committee members will be eligible for 3 CEUs upon completion of the review.

### **Eligibility and Criteria**

The MS CCR Standards for Social Studies Review Committee candidate must be a current, full-time, certified (K-12) teacher employed in a state-accredited Mississippi public school. In addition, the teacher must meet the following criteria:

- A minimum of three (3) years teaching experience
- Employed as a full-time, certified teacher in a state-accredited MS public school for the 2022 - 2023 academic year
- Strong knowledge and understanding of the current MS CCR Standards for Social Studies
- Strong written and verbal communication skills
