Background

The purpose of the Compact is to remove barriers to educational success imposed on children of military families because of frequent moves and deployment of their parents.

In March 2009, the state of Mississippi adopted Mississippi Code Annotated §37-135-31. This legislation allowed Mississippi to become a member of the Interstate Compact on Educational Opportunity for Military Children. The Compact regulations apply to all Mississippi public schools and Department of Defense Education Activity schools.

The purpose of the Compact is to remove barriers to educational success imposed on children of military families because of frequent moves and deployment of their parents. The Compact 101 Training provides participants with a brief history of how the Compact began followed by an overview of the provisions afforded to military-connected children in relation to their education. All attendees will receive a workbook and resource materials to assist them with implementing the Compact as they transition to various states throughout their family's time serving in the military.
