ARTS T.I.P. (TEACHING INSTRUCTIONAL PRACTICE)

Arts Education Eligibility under Titles I, II, and IV of ESSA Well-Rounded Education funding has several avenues for the arts to receive funding within ESSA. Title I, which focuses on providing personnel, instruction, and interventions to help close achievement gaps, can be used to address the huge, persistent disparities to access to arts education in public schools. Title II, which focuses on preparing, training, and recruiting high quality teachers, principals, and other school educators, can be utilized to obtain professional development funding for arts educators. Finally, Title IV, Part A, which contains the Student Support and Academic Enrichment Grants, may be used to support the arts as part of a well-rounded education.
