for students all summer and is free of charge to students enrolled in Mississippi K-12 public schools.

The program begins June 1, 2023.

You're in control. You and your child can see a UMMC nurse practitioner or licensed counselor on a smartphone, tablet or computer where you are.

Minor medical care

Available seven days a week 6 AM – 6 PM

Treating fever, stomach bugs, rashes, asthma, allergies, pink eye and other minor medical issues.

Behavioral health care

Available Monday to Friday 8 AM – 6 PM

Treating depression, anxiety and behavioral difficulties and offering medication management. Students aged 14 and older also have access to the SilverCloud® on-demand mental health app.
