The candidate must meet criteria outlined in MS Code 37-9-13 with a minimum of five (5) years of administrative experience in the central office of one or more school districts.

DEADLINE AND SELECTION

All materials submitted as part of the Superintendent application will be treated as confidential to the fullest extent allowed by law. The Board will review each candidate's submission and qualifications in an executive session, and may request an interview with one or more of the candidates. The successful candidate will be notified of their selection and will be expected to enter an employment contract with the District with a beginning date of July 1, 2024.

The Board reserves the right, however, to reject any and all applicants for the position of superintendent for any reason not prohibited by law.

All interested and qualified candidates wishing to be considered for the position should submit an application by October 2, 2023, and include:
