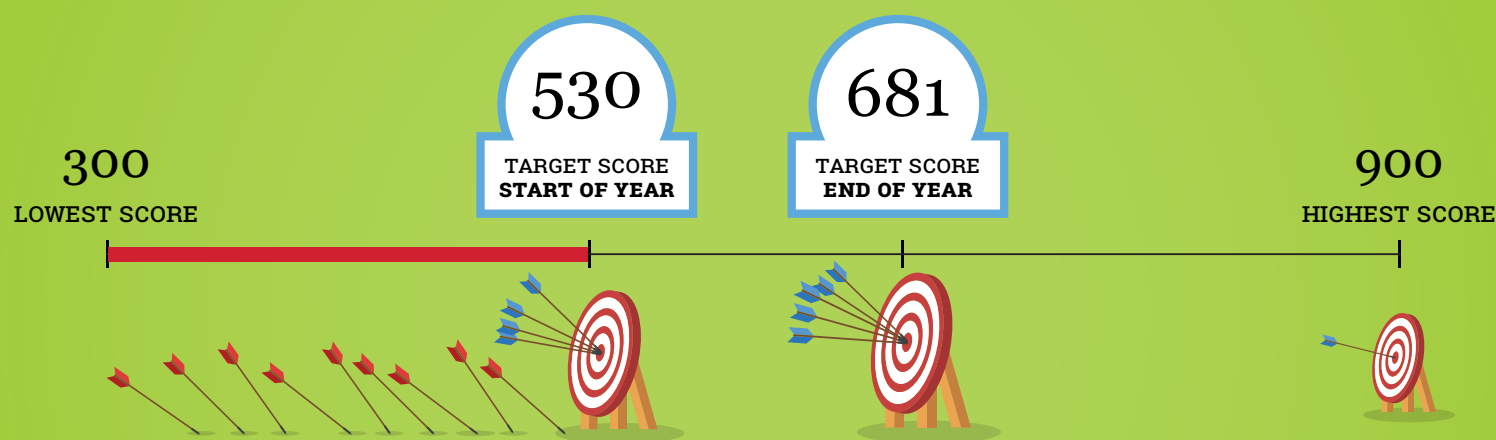


Is Your Kindergartener Ready to Learn to Read?

All Mississippi public-school children take a Kindergarten Readiness Assessment at the beginning of the school year. The score lets parents and teachers know whether students are on track to be proficient readers by the end of 3rd grade.

Kindergarteners who **score below 530** at the beginning of the year may need extra support or interventions to become better readers.
